VINEYARD

Red Mountain Estate Vineyard

Growing Conditions : Two thousand and seven had a warm summer and led to a typical harvest on September 17th. Fourteen year old vines with dual trunks, vertical shoot positioned trellis with bilateral cordons. The vines were cropped at a very low 3.5 tons per acre.

HARVEST

Sugar - 25.5° Brix / Titratable Acidity - 0.590g/100ml / pH - 3.69

WINEMAKING

Closed tank fermentation of three Syrah clones, Hermitage, Phelps and Cote Rotie, was followed by barrel aging sur lie for 30 months using French oak (48% new).

BOTTLE

Titrateable Acidity - 0.605g/100ml / pH - 3.68 / Alcohol - 13.5% by volume / Production - 1325 cases

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
