53% MERLOT, 41% CABERNET SAUVIGNON, AND 6% SYRAH

Our 2009 Batholith is another geology based name, paying homage to my geology roots, that represents the massive intrusions of igneous rock cooled below the surface, of which Half Dome in Yosemite is an exposed example. 2009 Batholith like the name implies is massive, a huge broad shouldered wine with an expansive mid-palate. 2009 Batholith is a blend based on the big deeply concentrated Merlot from our Red Mountain estate vineyard (a Merlot that comes across as big as Cab) along with Cabernet Sauvignon and a touch of Syrah both also from our Red Mountain estate vineyard. 2009 Batholith is an opulent blend with rich flavors of red and black fruits, an broad deep palate and a very smooth silky extended finish.

Growing Conditions : 2009 was a typical growing season although slightly cooler. Harvest dates of Merlot and Syrah were in mid-September, Cabernet Sauvignon in mid-October.
