GROWING CONDITIONS

The 2011 growing season was the coolest vintage in modern grape growing in Washington with a very cool spring and summer with an extended warm fall. The oldest Riesling vineyard still in production in commercial production in Washington with, 49 year old vines with dual trunks and bilateral cordons trained on a vertical shoot positioned trellis was cropped at a low 1.9 tons per acre.
