



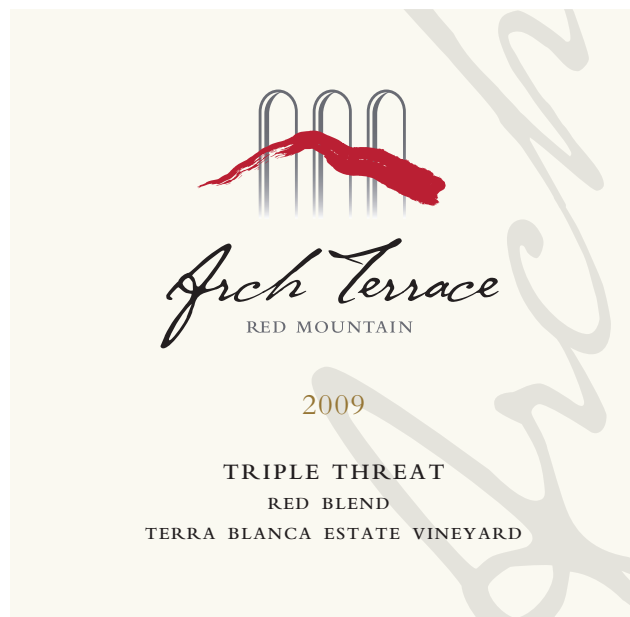
2009 ARCH TERRACE TRIPLE THREAT

GROWING CONDITIONS

The 2008 growing season was a typical year on Red Mountain, where a long warm spring led to a relatively warm dry summer and typical autumn. Up to sixteen year old vines with dual trunks and bilateral cordons trained on a vertical shoot positioned trellis were cropped at a low 2.4 to 3.1 tons per acre.

FERMENTATION

Fermentation in both open and closed tanks with a variety of yeast types and some multiple yeast fermentation help to create wines with huge fruit flavors and fine well integrated tannins. Aged for up to 32 months in French oak barrels.

Wines were bottle aged for over 12 months prior to release.
