VINEYARD

Red Mountain Estate Vineyard

Growing Conditions : The 2008 growing season had a cooler slightly delayed spring followed by moderate summer temperatures and overall a mild growing season. This allowed for harvest between September 30 and October 14. Vines were seventeen years old, grown in unilateral cordons on a vertical shoot position trellis. Vines were cropped at a very low 1.7-2.9 tons per acre. Our sustainably farmed vineyard is Salmon Safe certified.

HARVEST

Average Sugar - 24.8 ° Brix / Average Titratable Acidity - 0.500g/100ml / Average pH - 3.7

Fermentation in both open and closed tanks with a variety of yeast types. Aged for up to 32 months in French oak barrels, 78% new.

BOTTLE

Titrateable Acidity - 0.593g/100ml / pH - 3.79 / Alcohol - 13.5% by volume / Production - 661 cases
