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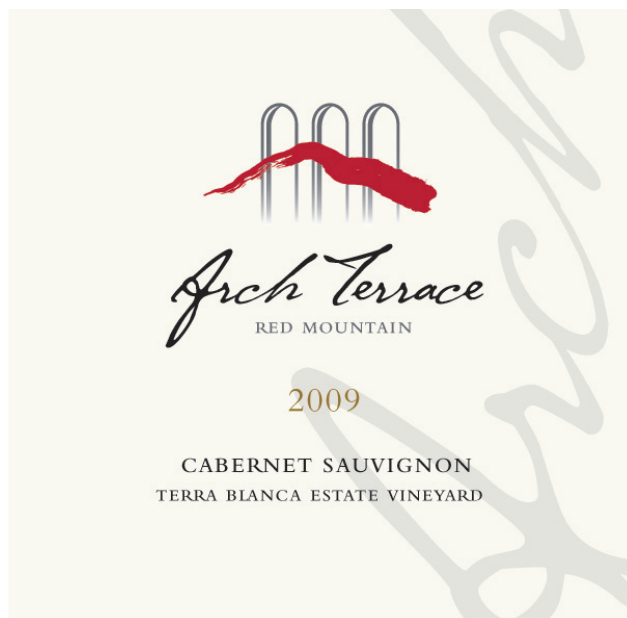
## 2009 ARCH TERRACE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

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### VINEYARD

Terra Blanca Estate Vineyard, Red Mountain

### GROWING CONDITIONS

The 2009 growing season was a typical year on Red Mountain, where a cooler slightly delayed spring led to a relatively warm dry summer and typical autumn. Seventeen year old vines with dual trunks and bilateral cordons trained on a vertical shoot positioned trellis were cropped at a low 2.6 tons per acre.

### HARVEST

Sugar - 24.7° Brix / Titratable Acidity - 0.510g/100ml / pH - 3.68  
Harvest occurred from October 10th to October 14th.

### WINEMAKING

Fermentation in open tanks with a variety of yeast types and some multiple yeast fermentation help to create wines with huge fruit flavors and fine well integrated tannins. Aged for up to 30 months in French oak barrels, 36% new.

### BOTTLE

Titrateable Acidity - 0.590g/100ml / pH - 3.74 / Alcohol - 13.5% by volume / Production - 3410 cases

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
