

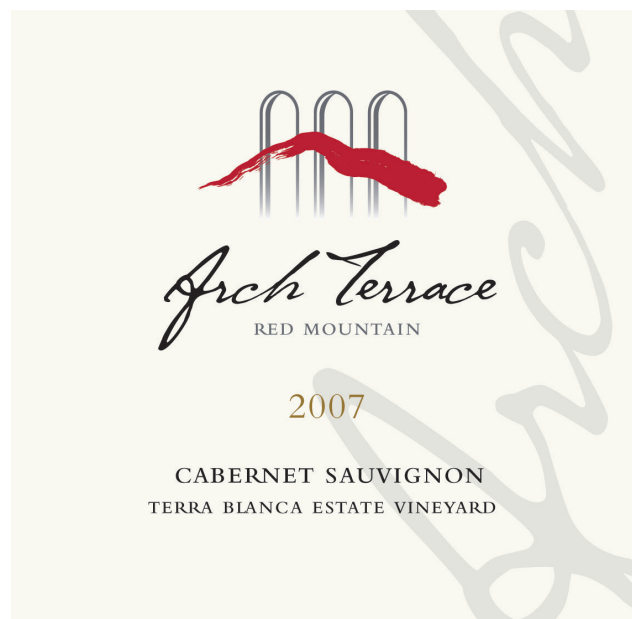
2007 ARCH TERRACE CABERNET SAUVIGNON

“Fragrant red raspberry, red currant with traces of cedar and orange marmalade on the nose lead into a lively, fruit forward Red Mountain Cabernet Sauvignon. On the palate bright fruit is supported by a firm structure and great acidity. This Cabernet Sauvignon will match beautifully with braised short ribs, roast leg of lamb or even a grilled salmon fillet. Aging potential of this wine is easily ten years or more.”

Terra Blanca Estate Vineyard, Red Mountain

Growing Conditions: The 2007 growing season was a typical year on Red Mountain, where a long warm spring led to a hot, dry summer and a typical autumn.

HARVEST

Sugar - 24.7° Brix / Total Acidity - 0.565g/100ml / pH - 3.3
Harvest occurred from October 11 to October 14

WINEMAKING

Fermented in open and closed tanks using multiple yeast types. Barrel aged for up to 32 months in French oak.

BOTTLE

Total Acidity - 0.720g/100ml / pH - 3.67 / Alcohol - 13.5% by volume / Production - 2200 cases

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
