After ten years of experimenting with different Italian varietals and clones at our estate vineyard, winemaker Keith Pilgrim has released the first of several Italian varietal based wines that will be released this year. Terra Blanca's philosophy is grounded in the relationship between the earth and the grape. Our 2003 Altissimo, a blend of 83% Sangiovese and 17% Cabernet Sauvignon, is named after the famed marble deposit in the Carrera region of Tuscany. The 2003 Altissimo is true to its Tuscan heritage, a wine that is strong and smooth with lasting beauty. But our Red Mountain estate Cabernet Sauvignon grapes add a French touch of structure and depth to the spicy red fruit of our Red Mountain estate Sangiovese grapes. Our 2003 Altissimo opens with a fragrance of strawberry and raspberry. Enjoy with pasta and red meat sauces, pork tenderloin in cracked black pepper, or simply on its own.

More forward and earlier maturing than the 1997, the 1998 ONYX has aged and is starting to open and show fruity velvetness leading to rich supple flavors of black fruit and chocolate resulting from the very warm 1998 growing season and relatively early fall. A dark, red-black colored wine with rich chocolate, black cherry, blackberry, cassis and eucalyptus nuances surrounded by full, yet soft tannins.

Raspberry and cherry with notes of violets lift from the glass and mingle with soft spice and toasted oak. Smooth, lush flavors of blackberry, black cherry and cassis wrap around a core of full, yet soft, structured tannins. Cedar notes with light touches of spice fold into lingering cherry and berry flavors surrounded by a sea of rich chocolate on the long silky finish. The very warm 2000 growing season coupled with the cool evenings produced an intense, ripe vintage. Low yields in the vineyard along with low-vigor growing techniques allowed the grapes to develop the concentration and depth of fruit that is a trademark for our Red Mountain estate vineyard.

Hints of leather and orange essence rise from the glass. Dark plum, fig, and cedar spice leave a deep impression on the palate. Floral and orange notes float over a velvet finish. 1999 Terra Blanca Syrah Block 8, combines the grace and power of Red Mountain, while preserving its Chateaufort du Pape heritage.
